## Pastor's Pen



This past Saturday we were getting ready to drive to Shrewsbury to get Drew over at Jeff and Karen's after he spent a week at the WILDS with them. Beth Ann had gone to the store and the kids were unloading the groceries just before we were going to get in and start our trip. Mike asked me to come out and look at the one tire – it was leaking air. This shouldn't be a problem... a slight delay, but nothing major. Well, as we started into the process to change the tire, we ran into a problem – we couldn't get the spare tire down! We followed all of the directions in the manual, but that thing would not come down. Right up under the car we had a completely unused tire but nothing we did jarred it lose from its storage spot. With time, effort, and a cutting wheel on a grinder we were able to get it down, but what would we have done if we were along the side of the road? Our mechanic told us that those under-the-car-spare-tire-storage-mechanisms consistently get stuck and don't allow the tire to come down. He said, "It looks good on paper, but somebody didn't take our northeastern weather into consideration!" It was so frustrating having a replacement that wouldn't move! There are times in our lives where we encounter a problem and we turn to the Lord, but it seems as though something is "stuck." We try all the things that we know to get that promise from the Word of God to work, but it won't come "down." What is the problem? Doesn't God care about us? I believe the answer lies in what the mechanic said about the spare tire under-the-car things – he said, "For them to work right, you should just wind them down and back up at least twice a year." In other words, use them when it's not an emergency! Maybe the reason our "spare tire" won't come down is because the only time we think about it is when we are in a crisis. Let's not be people that only turn to God and the Bible when there is a problem...let's put that "Mechanism" to use on a daily basis!
